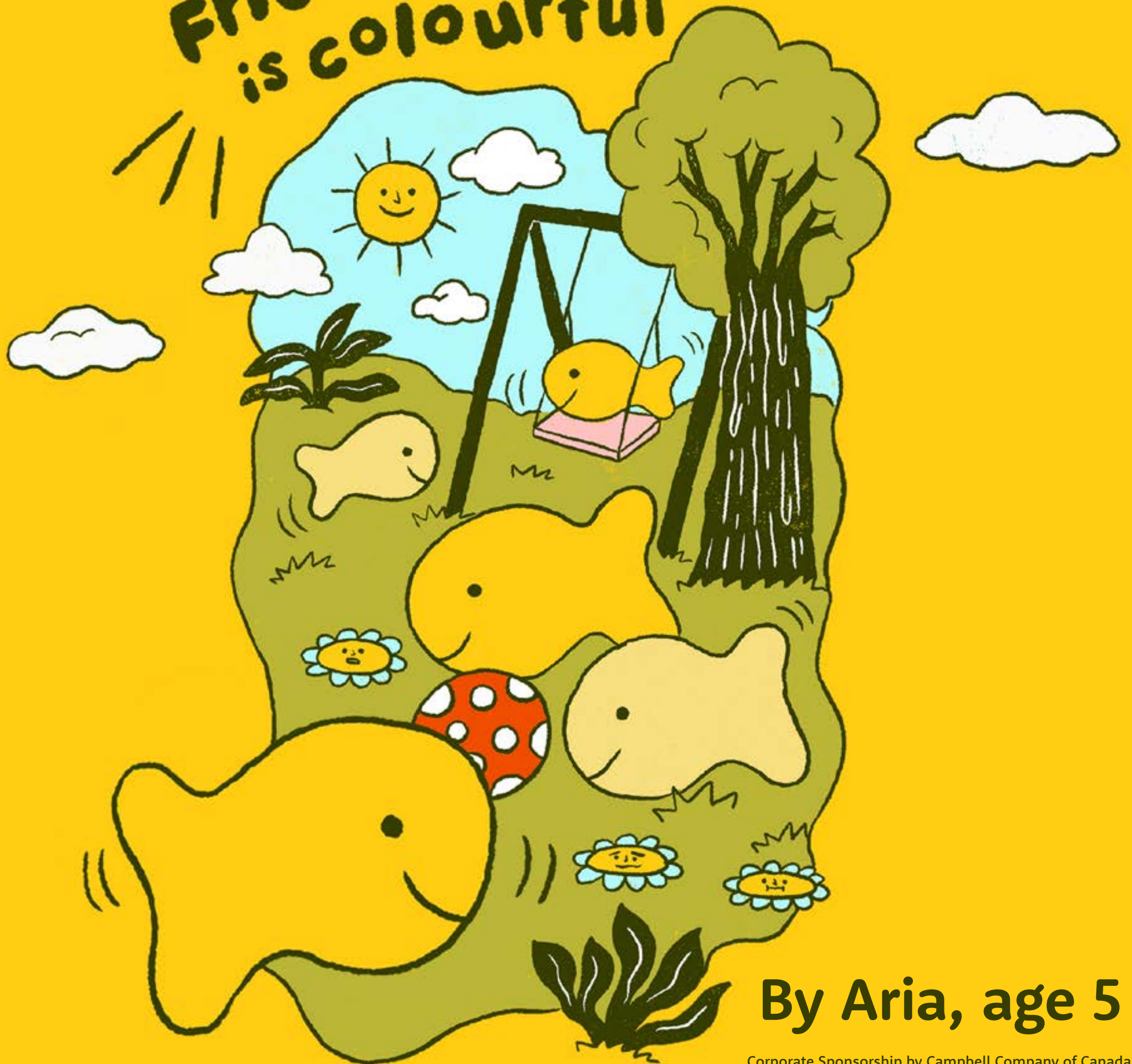

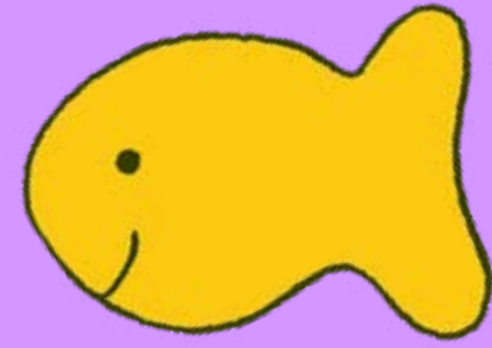

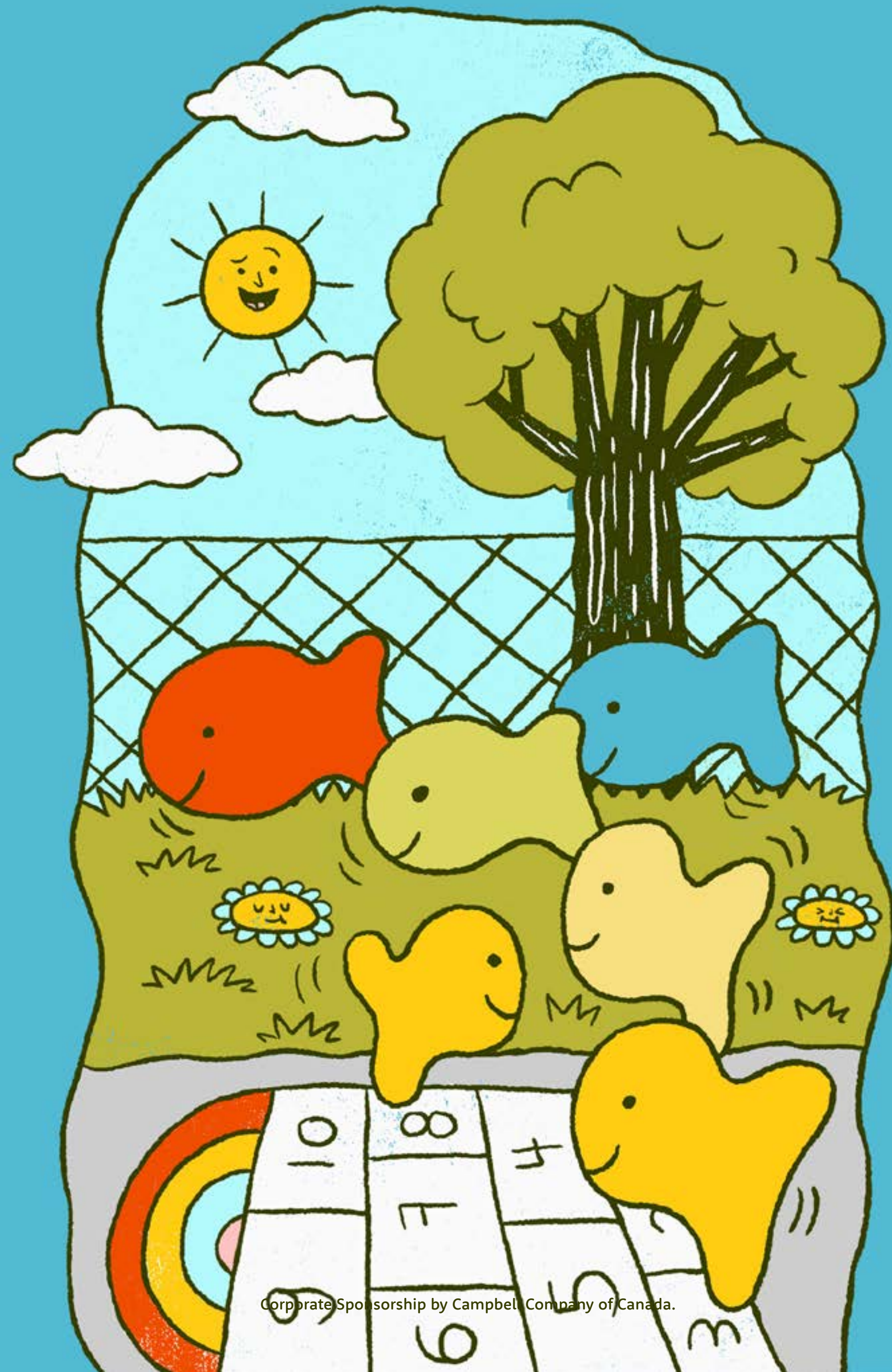


Once there was a

father and friends.







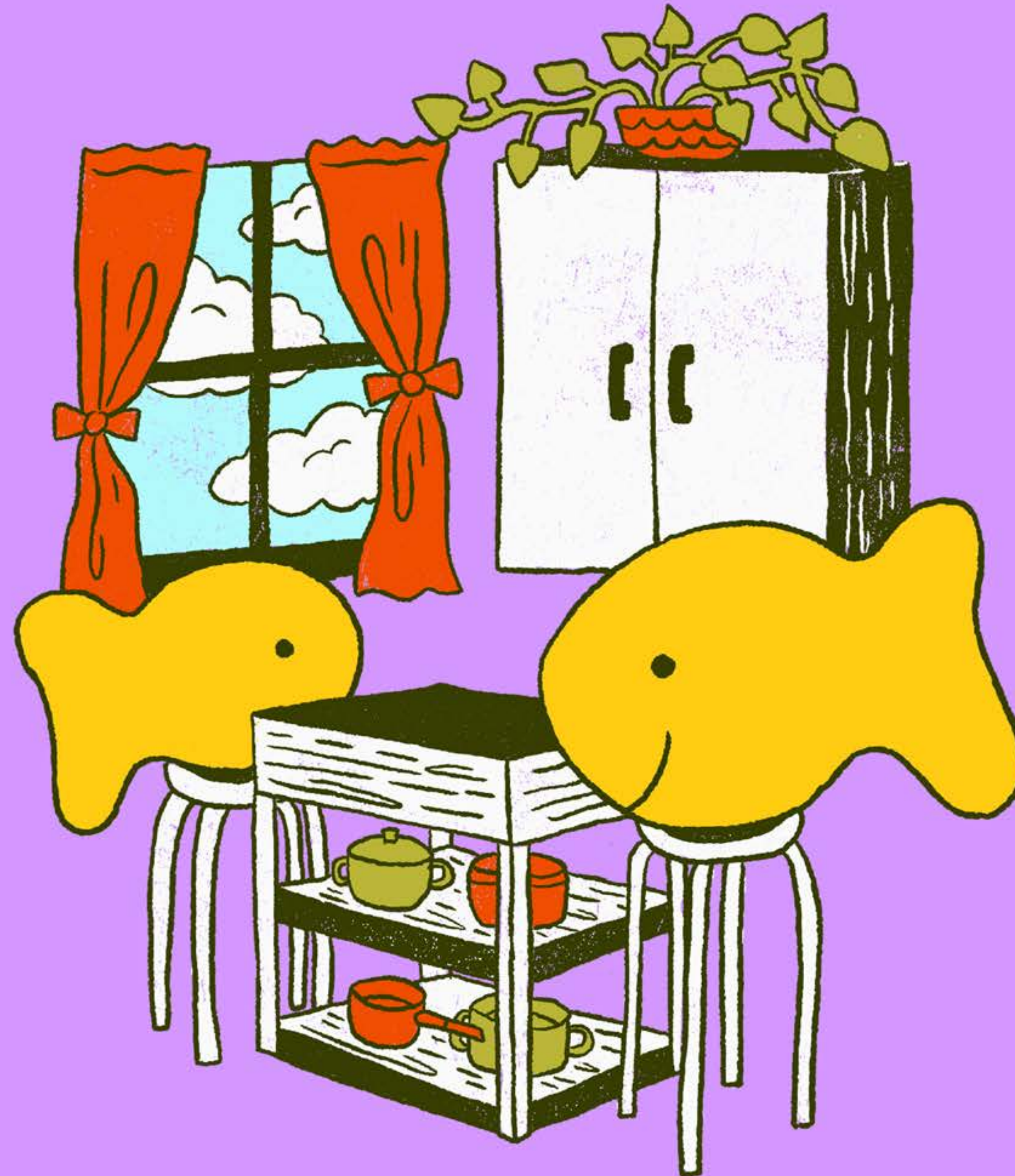
One day Flora saw

Her mother asked.

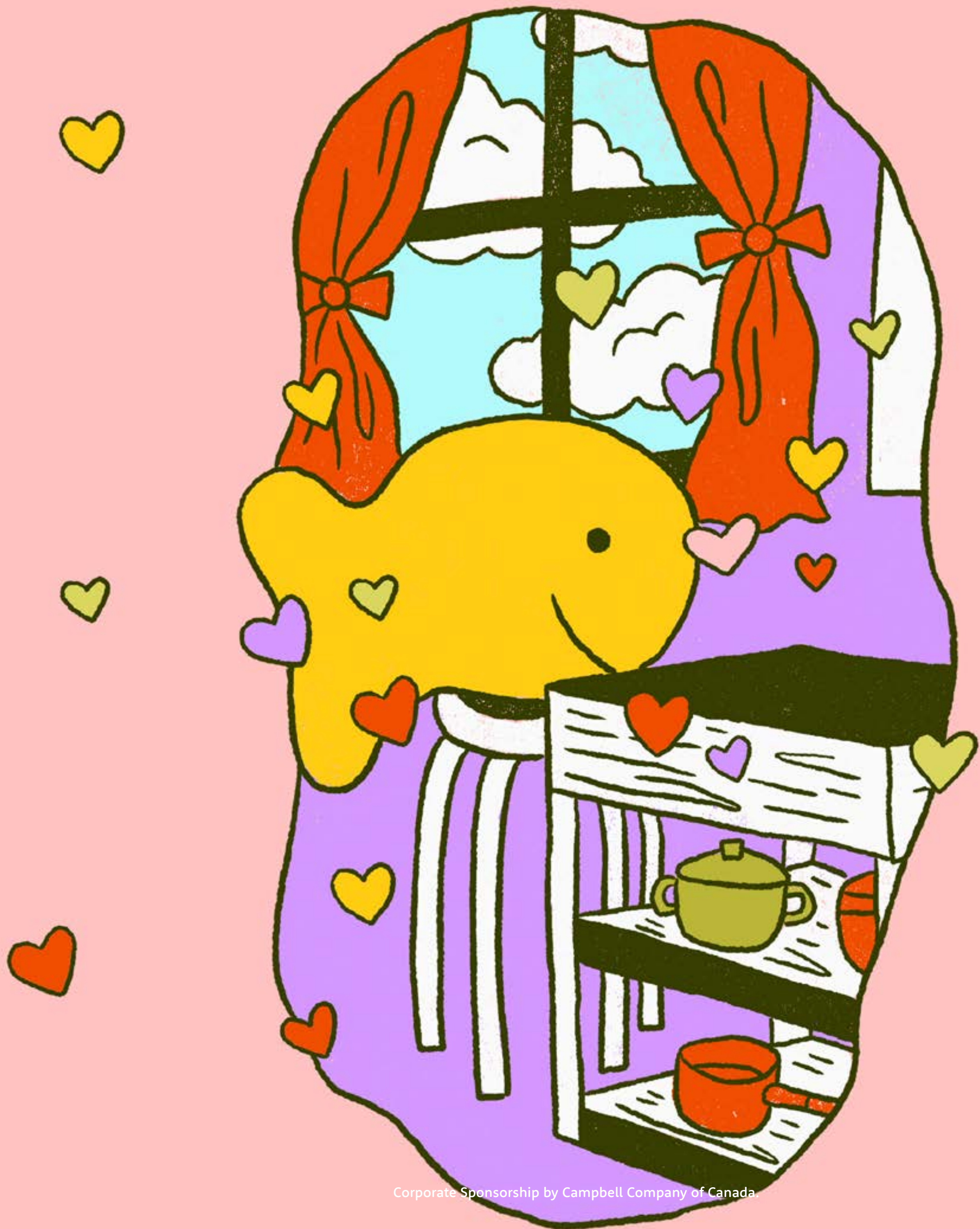


“Yes”, Flora replied.

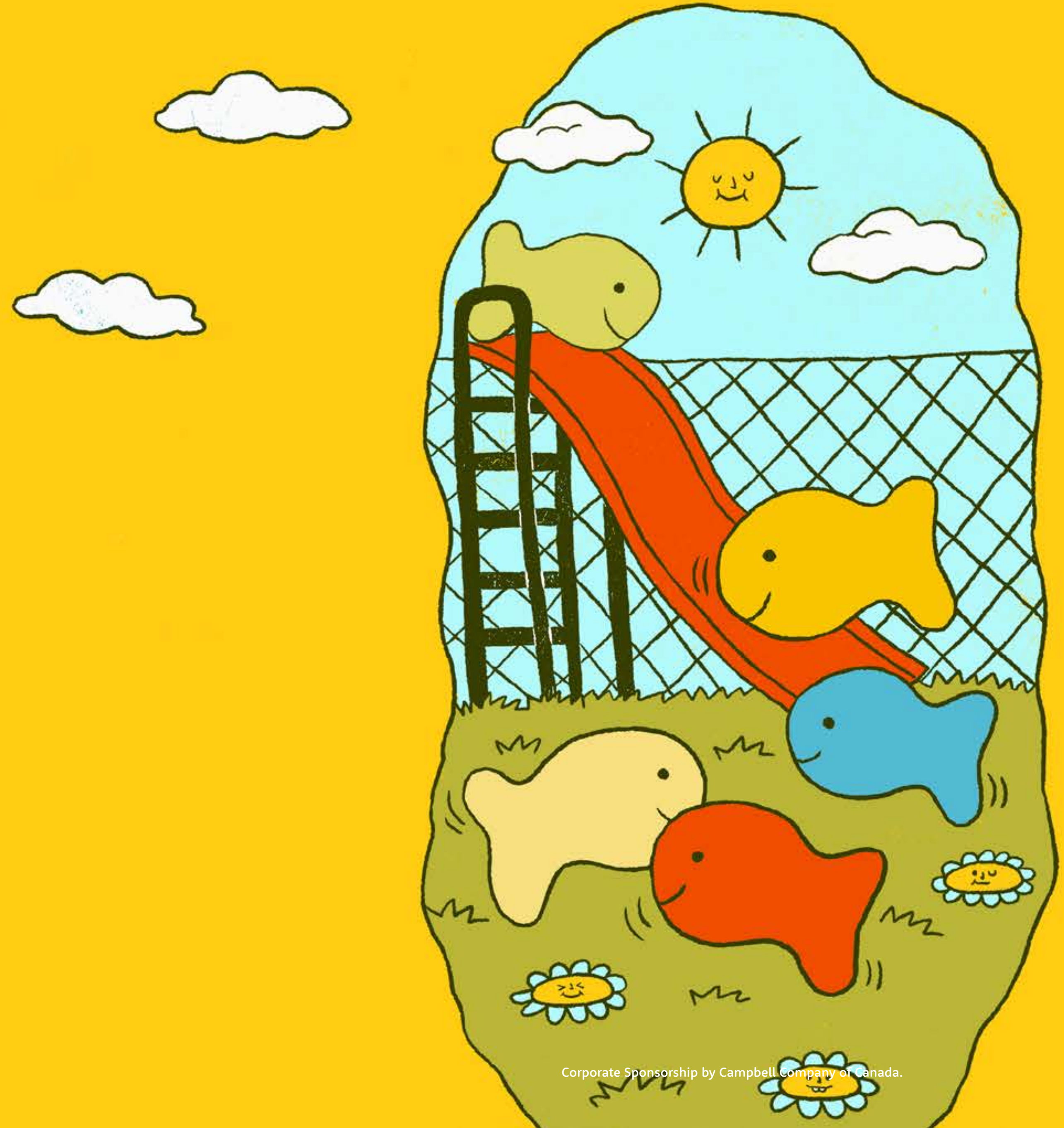

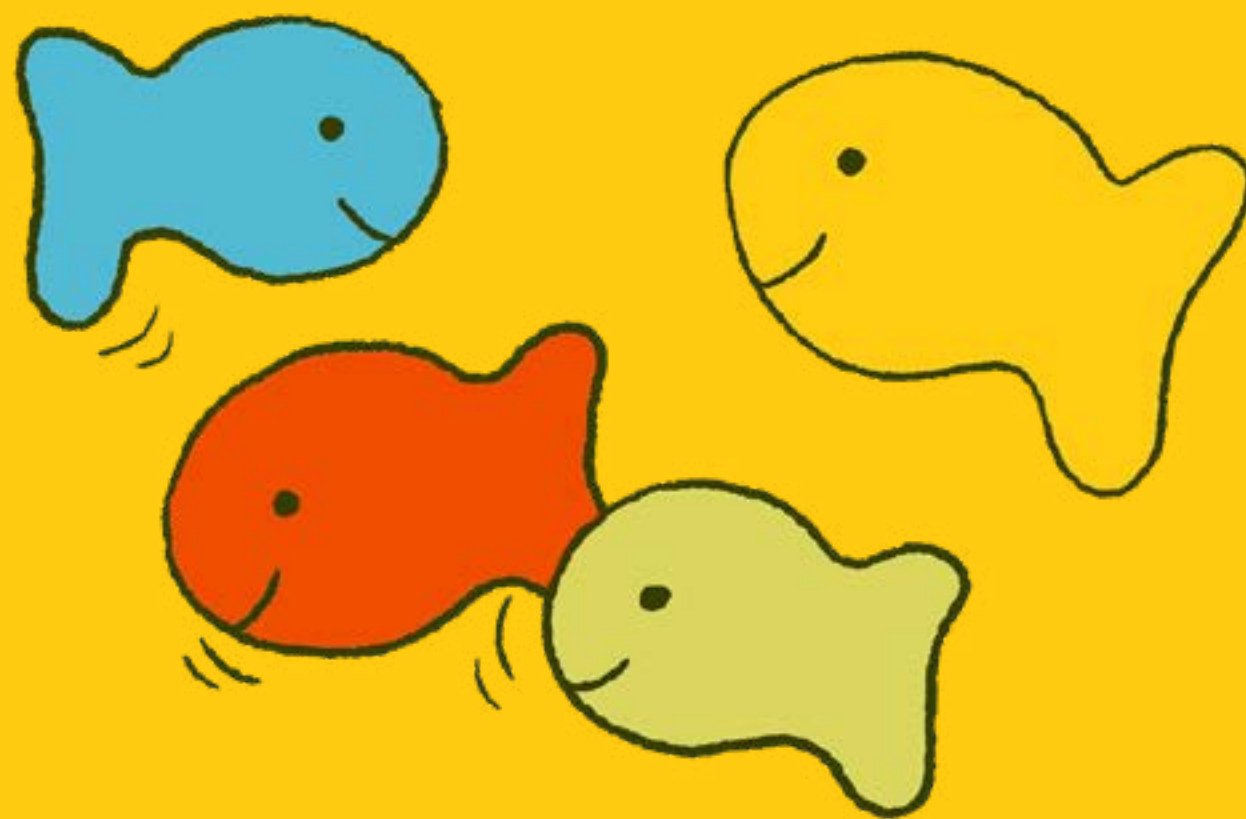
